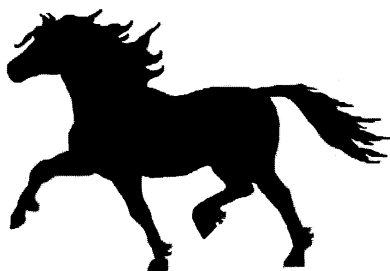

11. NPS/CHECKLEYBANK M&M NOVICE LEADING REIN WINTER CHAMPIONSHIP

This Competition is open to mares and geldings four years old or over which must be registered in the main body of their respective Mountain and Moorland Stud Book. Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, New Forest and Welsh Section A & B. Not exceeding 122cms.

Pony not to have won a first prize of £10 or more in any Leading Rein class. To be shown in a suitable snaffle bridle, the leading rein must be attached to the noseband only. The reins must go directly from the bit to the rider's hands

Riders must have attained their 3rd but not have attained their 9th birthday (riders' ages are as at 1st January in the current year).

12. NPS/CHECKLEYBANK M&M NOVICE FIRST RIDDEN WINTER CHAMPIONSHIP

This Competition is open to mares and geldings four years old or over, which must be registered in the main body of their respective Mountain and Moorland Stud Book.

Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, New Forest and Welsh Section A & B. Not exceeding 128cms. Pony not to have won a first prize of £10 or more in any First Ridden class. Ponies must not be cantered except in their individual show. To be shown in any suitable bridle.

Riders must have attained their 3rd but not have attained their 12th birthday (riders' ages are as at 1st January in the current year).

13. NPS / T.C. TACK & THINGS M&M LEADING REIN WINTER CHAMPIONSHIP

This Competition is open to mares and geldings four years old or over, which must be registered in the main body of their respective Mountain and Moorland Stud Book.

Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, New Forest and Welsh Section A & B. Not exceeding 122cms.

To be led by an attendant and shown in a snaffle bridle, the leading rein to be attached to the noseband only. The reins must go directly from the bit to the rider's hands.

Riders must have attained their 3rd but not have attained their 9th birthday (riders' ages are as at 1st January in the current year).

14. NPS/KBIS M&M FIRST RIDDEN WINTER CHAMPIONSHIP

This Competition is open to mares and geldings four years old or over, which must be registered in the main body of their respective Mountain and Moorland Stud Book.

Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, New Forest and Welsh Section A & B. Not exceeding 128cms.

Riders must have attained their 3rd but not have attained their 12th birthday (riders' ages are as at 1st January in the current year).

Mini Championship (1st & 2nd from classes 11 to 14)

Class 15. NOVICE PARTBRED WELSH RIDDEN (Unaffiliated)

Not to have won a first prize before January 2009. Rider any age (except stallions - See rules)

Class 16. OPEN PARTBRED WELSH RIDDEN (Unaffiliated)

Rider any age (except stallions - see rules)

Class 17. NPS / HIRSTMUND STUD M&M PURE NOVICE RIDDEN WINTER CHAMPIONSHIP – small breeds

This Competition is open to stallions, mares and geldings four years old or over which must be registered in the main body of their respective Mountain & Moorland Stud Book.

Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland and Welsh Section A & B.

Pony not to have been placed first in any Ridden Mountain & Moorland Class prior to the commencement of the current Winter Series. All ponies in this class must be shown in a snaffle bridle Rider any age (except stallions – see NPS Rules).

Class 18. NPS / HIRSTMUND STUD M&M PURE NOVICE RIDDEN WINTER CHAMPIONSHIP – large breeds

This Competition is open to stallions, mares and geldings four years old or over which must be registered in the main body of their respective Mountain & Moorland Stud Book

Connemara, Dales, Fells, Highlands, New Forest and Welsh Section C & D

Pony not to have been placed first in any Ridden Mountain & Moorland Class prior to the commencement of the current Winter Series. All ponies in this class must be shown in a snaffle bridle. Rider any age (except stallions – see NPS Rules)

Class 19. NPS / FIRLE STUD M&M NOVICE RIDDEN WINTER CHAMPIONSHIP – small breeds

This Competition is open to stallions, mares and geldings four years old or over which must be registered in the main body of their respective Mountain & Moorland Stud Book

Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland and Welsh Section A & B.

Pony not to have won a first prize of £10 or more in any open Ridden M&M Class. Ponies are to be shown in any suitable bridle. Rider any age (except stallions – see NPS Rules)

Class 20. NPS / FIRLE STUD M&M NOVICE RIDDEN WINTER CHAMPIONSHIP – large breeds

This Competition is open to stallions, mares and geldings four years old or over which must be registered in the main body of their respective Mountain & Moorland Stud Book

Connemara, Dales, Fells, Highlands, New Forest and Welsh Section C & D.

Pony not to have won a first prize of £10 or more in any open Ridden M&M Class. Ponies are to be shown in any suitable bridle. Rider any age (except stallions – see NPS Rules).

Class 21. NPS / SNUGGY HOODS M&M OPEN RIDDEN WINTER CHAMPIONSHIP – small breeds

This Competition is open to stallions, mares and geldings four years old or over which must be registered in the main body of their respective Mountain & Moorland Stud Book
Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland and Welsh Section A & B.
Rider any age (except stallions – see NPS Rules).

Class 22. NPS / SNUGGY HOODS M&M OPEN RIDDEN WINTER CHAMPIONSHIP – large breeds

This Competition is open to stallions, mares and geldings four years old or over which must be registered in the main body of their respective Mountain & Moorland Stud Book
Connemara, Dales, Fells, Highlands, New Forest and Welsh Section C & D.
Rider any age (except stallions – see NPS Rules)

NPS Winter Championship Qualifying Rounds

This show is affiliated to the National Pony Society and the NPS affiliated classes will be run under NPS rules. Classes are open to Members and Non-Members of the NPS, but Non-Members will need to become Adult Showing members to enter the finals at the NPS Spring Festival 2010.

The NPS General Rules for Showing apply.

In each class the three highest placed ponies, not already qualified, within the first six places, will qualify. Winnings in the 2008/2009 Novice and Pure Novice Winter Championships will not debar ponies from the NPS 2010 Mountain and Moorland Novice Ridden competitions.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. Neither the organisers, nor any of the show officers, servants or assistants shall be in any way responsible or accountable for any loss, injury or damage that may happen (for any cause or circumstance whatever) to exhibitors, their servants or assistants, or any member of the public, to any animal or property, or to any vehicle brought onto the showground, or on premises used in conjunction with the show, or while entering or leaving the same, or otherwise for anything else in conjunction with, or arising out of, or attributable to the Show. The Committee reserve the right to refuse an entry without giving any reason whatsoever.
2. Any objections must be lodged with the Secretary immediately, together with a deposit of £25.00 which will be returned if the objection is upheld.
3. The Committee reserve the right to change the judges. The decision of the judges will be final. All entries must be registered with the Welsh Pony & Cob Society, or their breed society or eligible for registration.
4. In the event of the Show being cancelled for whatever reason, the Committee reserve the right to keep a portion of the monies to cover expenses.
5. Exhibitors are NOT permitted to enter an animal in any class which is to be judged by a person who has, or had, any financial interest in the animal, or has been connected with it in any way. All exhibits shall be the bona fide property of the exhibitor or officially leased.
6. No substitution of entries will be accepted.
7. The Committee reserve the right to amalgamate or divide classes if deemed appropriate.
8. The Committee reserve the right to alter or amend the Conditions.
9. Exhibitors are asked not to bring a coughing horse to the show, and may be required to remove any such animal.
10. Exhibitors should ensure that they are adequately covered by third party insurance.
11. Only part bred may have plaited manes and tails.
12. Correct riding attire must be worn at all times. **ALL RIDERS**, whether competing or not must wear correct headgear; it is recommended that people wear current standards, but riders have to be responsible for their own safety. Failure to do so will incur elimination
13. £10 Deposit for all Trophies, Cups and Shields won on the day.
