



SCWPCA Foal Show 2005 Report & Results

A cold clear November morning saw 81 foals and yearlings entered for the SCWPCA 18th annual foal and 5th annual Yearling show at Crofton Manor Equestrian Centre. A spacious arena saw some quality entries forward for the two judges Mrs Jenny Kilbey of the Idyllic Stud and Mrs Tirion Thomas of the Abercippyn Stud. Mrs Kilbey commented that the "exhibitors were wonderful" and it was lovely to have a group of unbiased genuine exhibitors who when they asked for her opinion were happy to accept her comments. She found her Section A champion from the 9 fillies forward with Mr J B Jones Lapstone Ulah on her first time out. Homebred by their stallion Lapstone Pengannon out of Dargale Utopia this filly really showed off and is a full sister to the Glanusk winner Lapstone Ulysees and Lapstone UMBER who was second at the Royal Welsh. She went on to be Reserve Supreme Foal and SCWPCA Owner Breeders Reserve Supreme Foal. The section reserve came from the same class with Barry and Val Whites palomino filly Hawksworth Norma Jean. This is their first year of homebred Section A's and they were also second in the colt foal class with Hawksworth Dungood. Norma Jean is by Bryndorian Tomas out of Boniface Nell Gwyn who was supreme in hand at the SCWPCA Summer Medal Show 2004. The winner of the colt class was another of Vanessa Mardens G-line colts Ronswood Glory out of Breaklands Gale Force this time by Churchwood President. All this mares colts have been prolific winners for the stud as youngstock and this good moving roan looks like another one to follow in their footsteps having also won his class at the NPS Wessex foal show the previous week.

The section A yearling colt/gelding winner was another homebred pony Diane Drakes Wintersend Solomon, her first homebred pony he is by Blanche Midas out of Kinmel Sara who Diane sold at this years Fayre Oaks sale. He had 2 outings as a foal being second on both occasions and this being his third outing went on to be the SCWPCA Owner Bred Yearling Supreme. Beating 'Solo' to the yearling Sec A championship was Jamie Rogers palomino filly Blanche Magnolia. By Blanche Mikado out of Blanche Marilla she is no stranger to the show ring having been shown successfully as a foal and as a yearling this year and she took the Reserve Supreme Yearling title here.

Section B foals were very thin on the ground with low pre show entries not boosted on the day as normal. The Nutbourne Studs Brynoffa Breeze took the Sec B Foal Championship at her first show. She is by Griashall Kiwi out of Brynoffa Bianca and was purchased by the stud at Fayre Oaks. Reserve to her was Mr Hawton-Checkleys smart bay colt Elvet Royalist, purchased direct from the Elvet stud he is by Elvet Challenger out of Rotherwood Royal Poppy. The winning section B yearling championship was Ruth Mackenzies colt Brynoffa Burberry, a full brother to the filly foal winner he nearly didn't make it to the show being a little reluctant to load in the morning. This his second outing is part of his education for next years show season and he will be going on from here to the Winter Fair. The yearling filly winner was the Nutbourne Studs homebred Nutbourne Oklahoma by Holyoake Whispering Grass out of Kingsmead Tamarisk.

Welsh partbred classes always produce an interesting mixture of types and this year we had 2 colt foals forward and 5 fillies. The PB foal championship went to the colt class winner Mrs Janet Babeys Royal Sovereign. A full brother to last years PB champion foal this striking well marked grey colt is by the Arab stallion Merry Duke out of a Sec C mare Plasdavrene Red Rosie. The filly class was won by Mrs A Kennedys strawberry roan Arllwynda. Out of a Dutch warmblood mare by the cob stallion Arllwyn Dafydd she also won at the summer show and has been successfully shown with her dam over the summer with notably a very



good win at Dorchester in the hunter foal class. Bred for her temperament and for performance she is a good example of the versatile large partbred. Staunch supporter of the SCWPCA partbred classes for many years Jeff Townsends filly Midtown Magic was the partbred yearling champion. Another out of the successful brood mare Heidi she has been successfully shown as a Hunter Pony until she grew a bit too big and has since been successful in Riding Horse and Sports Horse youngstock classes. She was 1st in her three classes at NPS Wessex the previous week winning the Riding Horse, Sports Horse and Partbred yearling classes.

Tirion Thomas commented that she had some very nice classes forward. One of the biggest of the day was the Sec C colt class won by Pete and Lesley Husseys striking black colt D'Abernon Sugar Ray. By their successful stallion Hengwys Tywysog who needs no introduction out of Tonlyn Lady Carla he is the full brother to last years colt winner D'Abernon Prince of Wales. He was following up a win at the EWPCA show. Second in the class was another D'Abernon colt RnB owned by Frank Johnson but this one chestnut and by the 2002 Sec C foal champion D'Abernon Rock DJ. You might have thought you were seeing double in the filly class when Alan Deabill and Malcolm Peatys Drogheda Moonshadow entered the ring. Another black with four whites by Hengwys Tywysog out of Tireinon Fashionette she had the edge in the Sec C championship over the colt and went right through the card winning the Foal Supreme and the Owner Bred Foal Supreme championships on only her first outing. There were no Section C yearlings forward which was disappointing but we will persevere with the classes and hope for more next year. Another good class of 8 colt foals were forward for the Section D's which was a big improvement on last year. First and Section champion was Lisa Saints homebred Southcoast Parker, by their young Supreme Champion stallion Southcoast Mr Tom he is one of their promising first crop of foals by Tom out of Meaux Blodyn Ynyswyth. The second place colt Coednewydd Kentucky Express was a Builth cob sales purchase for his owners Messrs Woodvine and Hewer and another at his first show, he took the reserve section championship. The section D filly class was won by C Colasanti's Marwell Beatrice, by Nebo Thomas out of Marwell Xantia another of the good homebred ponies seen at the show also on her first time out. Sec D yearlings were out in higher numbers than last year and the colt class was won by another Builth Cob sales purchase Jo Stones Cruglwyd Emlyn. Purchased to go on to be a ridden cob he is by Bryngargoed ap Victor out of Tardebigge Ella. At Wessex NPS show he was reserve supreme and is another going to the Winter Fair. Second to Emlyn was J Harris's Harriswood Crackerjack who was Reserve Champion Owner Bred Yearling and is by Grayswood Magic Buccaneer and out of Chelwood Princess Gardinia. The winner of the Section D yearling filly class took the section title and went on to be overall Supreme Yearling Champion. Again purchased at the recent cob sales Nick Snellings Cefncoch Sian fully appreciated the size of the arena, not sure that Nick did though! to give a great display. By Brynithon New Image out of Cefncoch Catrin she is not doubt one to look out for in the future.

As one of the judges commented there were some lovely animals forward in the championship and it was nice too see so many homebred animals belonging to SCWPCA members doing so well at the show.
