- Class 45.** Open to Welsh A & B, registered in their respective Pure Bred Societies. Mare or gelding, four years old or over not exceeding 122 cm (Partbreds are not eligible.) Riders must have attained their 3rd birthday but must not have attained their 9th birthday before the 1st January in the current year. To be led by an attendant and shown in a snaffle bridle, the lead rein to be attached to the noseband only. All ponies to be shown in one of the snaffle bridles illustrated on page 62 of NPS 2009 Showing and Competition Rules.

NPS RULES

NPS Mountain and Moorland Qualifying Rounds:

These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. Ponies must be registered in the main body of their respective Mountain & Moorland Stud Books. Part bred are not eligible. Ponies to be trimmed only within their Breed Society specification. Manes must not be plaited and tails must not be braided. As this is a breed show Non Members will be eligible to qualify for the final, to be held at the NPS Summer Championship Show 2010. Non-members are required to become adult showing members of the NPS in order to compete in the final. The first prize winners from each class will go forward to the Final. A pony may only qualify once. Where the first pony in the class has already qualified, the pony standing next in line which has not qualified will be deemed the qualifier. Qualification may go no lower than third place.

NPS Silver Medal Championship Conditions.

These Championships are judged under the Rules of the NPS. As this is a breed show non members may be awarded NPS Silver Medal Rosettes, however they must become members of the NPS in order to be eligible to compete in the final. If the Champion pony has previously qualified it is still entitled to the Silver Medal Rosette but the Qualification Card goes to the Reserve Champion pony. The Silver Medal Rosette and the Qualification Card can be awarded no lower than first Reserve

Qualifiers are entitled to compete in the final of the Silver Medal Championship to be held at the NPS Summer Championship Show in August 2010, providing they send to the NPS Secretariat the relevant entry fee and qualification card.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. The organisers, nor any of the show officers, servants or assistants shall be in any way responsible or accountable for any loss, injury or damages that may happen (for any cause or circumstances whatever) to exhibitors or their servants or assistants, or any other member of the public, to any animal or property, or to any vehicle brought onto the Showground, or on premises used in conjunction with the show, or while entering or leaving the same or otherwise for anything else in conjunction with, or arising out of, or attributable to the show.
2. The committee reserve the right to refuse an entry without giving a reason whatsoever.
3. Any objections must be lodged, in writing, with the Secretary immediately with a deposit of £20.00 which will be returned if the objection is upheld.
4. The Committee reserve the right to change the judges, **the decision of the judges & their interpretation of the rules will be final.** A judge may require that a pony which constitutes a danger to leave the ring. All entries **MUST** be registered, or be eligible for registration, with their eligible breed society. All ponies entering medal classes must be registered/eligible for registration with Welsh Pony and Cob society.
5. **All Cups and Trophies will only be presented to fully paid up members.** A DEPOSIT of £20 TO BE PAID returnable on receipt of the cup by the required date in the condition in which it was presented. (Receipt must be shown before money returned)
6. In the event of the show being cancelled for whatever reason, the Committee reserves the right to keep a portion of monies to cover the expenses.
7. Exhibitors are **NOT** permitted to enter an animal in any class which is to be judged by a person who had, or has, any financial interest in the animal or been connected with it in any way. The Committee reserve the right to amalgamate or divide classes, if deemed appropriate. The Committee reserve the right to alter or amend the conditions. Exhibitors are requested not to bring a coughing horse to the show and may be requested to remove any such animal.
8. Dogs must be kept on a lead at all times.
9. Fall of horse/rider in any class will result in disqualification (from that class). The rider must not remount in the ring.
10. **All riders must have attained their 3rd birthday and the SCWP&CA recommend that a parent or guardian be available at the ring side when children are riding in classes off the lead rein.**
11. Correctly fastened hard hats to the current recommended British Standard are to be worn at all times when mounted on any part of the Showground **and although not a rule it is recommended by the SCWP&CA that all competitors 18 years and under wear a correctly fastened hard hat when showing in hand.**
12. All stallions and Colts 3 Years old or over MUST be in possession of a current Ministry of Agriculture, NPS or Breed Society Licence.
13. Riding of Exhibits will be at the Judge's discretion.
14. Exhibitors must ensure that Third Party Insurance adequately covers them.
15. Barren mares not to have reared a live foal in the current year.
16. Foals must be at least 3 weeks of age and be accompanied by their dam into the ring.
17. Plaiting of manes and tails is not permitted in any class except partbreds
18. Novice ridden classes entrants to be shown in a suitable snaffle bridle.
19. Riders of stallions must have attained their **11th** birthday before 1st January of the current year when riding small breeds (Welsh A & B) and for large breeds (Welsh C & D) riders must have attained their 14th birthday before 1st January
20. LITTER – Due to several complaints after our Spring 2008 show at Newbury, we would like to ask that everyone clear their own rubbish away. Black waste bins will be sited around the showground. It would be sincerely appreciated if this was adhered to.
