

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. The organisers, nor any of the show officers, servants or assistants shall be in any way responsible or accountable for any loss, injury or damages that may happen (for any cause or circumstances whatever) to exhibitors or their servants or assistants, or any other member of the public, to any animal or property, or to any vehicle brought onto the Showground, or on premises used in conjunction with the show, or while entering or leaving the same or otherwise for anything else in conjunction with, or arising out of, or attributable to the show. The committee reserve the right to refuse an entry without giving a reason whatsoever.
2. Any objections must be lodged, in writing, with the Secretary immediately with a deposit of £20.00 which will be returned if the objection is upheld.
3. The Committee reserve the right to change the judges, **the decision of the judges & their interpretation of the rules will be final.** A judge may require that a pony which constitutes a danger to leave the ring. All entries **MUST** be registered, or be eligible for registration, with the Welsh Pony & Cob Society.
4. **All Cups and Trophy's will only be presented to members fully paid up on 31st January each year.** A DEPOSIT TO BE PAID returnable on receipt of the cup by the required date in the condition in which it was presented.
5. In the event of the show being cancelled for whatever reason, the Committee reserves the right to keep a portion of monies to cover the expenses.
6. Exhibitors are **NOT** permitted to enter an animal in any class which is to be judged by a person who had, or has, any financial interest in the animal or been connected with it in any way. All exhibits shall be the bona fide property of the exhibitor or officially leased through the Welsh Pony & Cob Society. The Committee reserve the right to amalgamate or divide classes, if deemed appropriate. The Committee reserve the right to alter or amend the conditions. Exhibitors are requested not to bring a coughing horse to the show and may be requested to remove any such animal.
7. Dogs must be kept on a lead at all times.
8. Fall of horse/rider in any class will result in disqualification (from that class). The rider must not remount in the ring.
9. All riders must have attained their 3rd birthday and the SCWP&CA recommend that a parent or guardian be available at the ring side when children are riding in classes off the lead rein.
10. Correctly fastened hard hats to the current recommended British Standard are to be worn at all times when mounted on any part of the Showground **and although not a rule it is recommended by the SCWP&CA that all competitors 18 years and under wear a correctly fastened hard hat when showing in hand.**
11. All stallions and Colts 3 Years old or over MUST be in possession of a current Ministry of Agriculture, NPS or Breed Society Licence.
12. Riding of Exhibits will be at the Judge's discretion.
13. Exhibitors must ensure that they are adequately covered by Third Party Insurance.
14. Barren mares not to foal in the current year. No Foals on the show ground.
15. Plaiting of manes and tails is not permitted in any class except partbreds
16. **The Committee reserves the right to refuse an entry without giving a reason.**

RULES

EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE RULE BELOW FOR ALL NPS QUALIFYING CLASSES THESE CLASSES TO BE JUDGED UNDER THE RULES OF THE NPS

NPS Mountain and Moorland Qualifying Rounds: These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. Ponies must be registered in the main body of their respective Mountain & Moorland Stud Books. Part bred are not eligible.

Qualifying rounds for most NPS competitions are open to ponies owned by NPS members and non-members but only ponies owned by adult NPS members are eligible to qualify for the final of the competition at the NPS Summer Championship Show at Malvern from 4-6th August 2010.

The highest placed pony owned by an NPS member in each class will qualify for the final. Where this pony has already qualified the pony standing next in line which is owned by an NPS member and has not already qualified receives the qualification. Qualification may go no lower than 3rd place. Judges and/or stewards are requested to check membership cards prior to presenting the qualifying rosettes and cards. NPS Adult/Standard members will be required to upgrade to Adult/Showing to enter the final.

NPS/Rosettes Direct Home Produced Ridden Championship - Riders of Home Produced ponies (see definition in the NPS Rules Book) can wear a white arm band in classes where this is indicated. These ponies, if owned by NPS members, are then eligible to qualify for the final at the NPS Summer Championship Show.

NPS Silver Medal Rosette Championships: These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. NPS Silver Medal Rosettes are awarded when the owner of the champion pony is a member of the NPS. A valid membership card must be in the rider's possession on entering the ring and be produced immediately on request by either the judge or the steward. If the owner of the champion pony is not a member or the owner's membership card is not immediately produced, the rosette may be awarded to the Reserve Champion provided they have the required membership card. If the Champion pony has previously qualified it is still entitled to the Silver Medal Rosette but the qualification card goes to the Reserve Champion pony, provided the owner of that pony is a member of the NPS. The Silver Medal Rosette and the qualification card can be awarded no lower than first Reserve.

Rosettes, Prizes and Cups

- 6 place rosettes in each class
- SCWPCA Junior Members and SCWPCA Members rosettes to the highest place Junior Member and Senior Member in each class.
- Breeder Rosettes awarded for Inhand classes only.

To be judged under the Rules of the NPS.** Open to registered Mountain and Moorland Mare or Gelding 4 yrs old or over not exceeding 128cm (12.2hh) registered in the Pure Bred Section of the Breed Society Stud Books of Welsh Section A or B. Riders must have attained their 3rd birthday but must not have attained their 12th birthday before 1st Jan in the current year. Ponies never to have won a first prize of £10 or more in first ridden classes or qualified for NPS Micor Demolition M+M First Ridden Final before 1st January in the current year.
33. **The National Pony Society/Micor Demolition Ltd Mountain and Moorland Lead Rein National Championship. To be judged under the Rules of the NPS.** Open to registered Mountain and Moorland Mare or Gelding 4 years old or over not exceeding 122cm (12.0hh) registered in the Pure Bred section of the Breed Society stud books of Welsh Section A or B. Riders must have attained their 3rd birthday but must not have attained their 9th birthday before 1st Jan in the current year.
